Please remember to check your child's hair every Friday, making Friday "**Bug Busting Day**".

Facts about head lice:

1. Head lice are small insects that live very close to the scalp.
2. Nits are not the same as lice. Nits are the empty egg cases which stick to the hair.
3. Anybody can get head lice, both adults and

children.

4. Head lice don't care if hair is long, short, dirty or clean!
5. Head lice do not restrict themselves to school. They can be found ANYWHERE in the community!
6. Head lice can walk from one head to another if the heads are close together. They do not fly, jump or swim.
7. Regular hair care

may help to spot lice early.

8. Conditioner and a good combing is just as effective as chemical products.
9. If you require further information please call in and speak to the School Nurse. She is in school every Friday from 3pm.
